2. You must also ensure the following, required documents are submitted as part of the application process:

- A. A LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION sent directly from a teacher/professor/counselor no more than six months old.
- B. A copy of a letter from your college's Dean of Admissions attesting to your admission (for H.S. students starting college).
- C. An **OFFICIAL** COPY of your most recent TRANSCRIPT sent directly from your high school or college.

Applicants are responsible for ensuring that all required documentation is received by the deadline. Incomplete and late application packets including incomplete or late application form, missing or late documents, will automatically be denied.
